He has a nice fleece that would be useful to a hand spinner – 1kg at around 20 micron for 2023 shearing.

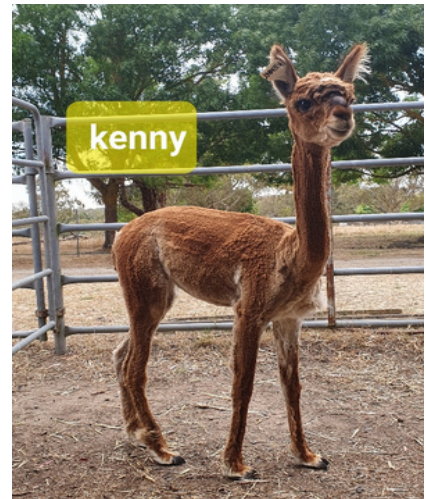
Latte – Medium Fawn wether, DOB 24-9-2014. This slightly older would be best suited as a guard. \$330 **SOLD**
